



Tile Magnets

Supply List:

- Glue Gun
- 3 - 2" tiles
- 3 - button magnets (about 3/4")
- 3 - 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" vinyl images



INSTRUCTION

1. Peel 3 tiles away from the mesh backing;



2. Peel the paper backing off of one of your vinyl pieces. Center the vinyl on a tile and rub. Peel off the transfer tape. Repeat on the two remaining



3. Glue the magnets on the back with a hot glue gun.



4. Enjoy this super cheap and fun gift idea!



TIPS:

The tiles come in a sheet. The sheet has 30 tiles on it. You can find these at Home Depot or Lowe's for about \$2. Buy the ones with a paper or mesh backing. They are much easier to take apart.

Sarapnfont.com has a great selection of fonts. Since these are fonts they work great with the SCAL program and your Cricut.

These make great gifts - just place them in a cellophane bag and tie with some cute ribbon!

These are a great group project to do. Fun with a church group, youth groups, or just a group of friends!
